Elsevier BV have created a publicly available database of over 100,000 top-scientists that provides standardized information on citations, h-index, co-authorship adjusted hm-index, citations to papers in different authorship positions and a composite indicator. Scientists are classified into 22 scientific fields and 176 sub-fields. Field- and subfield-specific percentiles are also provided for all scientists who have published at least 5 papers. In the single year impact database category Dr. Ranjit Thakuria from the Department of Chemistry, Gauhati University was selected among the top 100,000 scientists by c-score (with and without self-citations) or a percentile rank of 2% or above. The database is based on the Aug 01, 2021 snapshot from Scopus and is updated to citation year 2020.
