Understanding a micro-area, i.e. a village Panchayat, C.D. Block, Drainage Basin, Forest Fringe, urban area, urban fringe, etc. in terms of its physical and socio-economic components and their interaction and interrelationship for evolving strategies for sustainable development constitutes an important dimension of research in the field of Applied Geography. Such studies which largely involve application of modern tools and techniques including carto-statistical analysis, multivariate analysis, Remote Sensing, GIS and GPS require basic understanding of research methodology of micro-level analysis in proper perspective. With this aim in view the Department proposes to conduct summer school during July 7-27, 2009 with financial support of the DST, Govt. of India to train the potential young researchers in the field of Geography by utilizing the available laboratory and library facilities being developed recently under UGC's SAP and DST's FIST Programmes. The theme of the Summer School is "Micro- Level Area Study for Evolving Strategies for Sustainable Development".

Broad sub-themes: (i) Research Methodology for Micro-level Area Study.
(ii) Application of Carto-statistical Techniques and Geoinformatics in Micro-level Area Study.

Target trainees for the course: Post-graduate in Geography (preferably below 35 year of age) including College/University teachers and potential researchers.
