### **Instruction for Internal Assessment and End Semester Examinations in TDC Semester System.**

As approved by the honourable Vice-Chancellor, Gauhati University vide his order dt. 16/8/11, it is notified for information of all concerned that the University has decided the following.

- (1) The University will not supply the answer scripts for Internal Assessment. The unused answer scripts, if any, may be used by the Colleges. If required, the Colleges may provide blank answer scripts, affixing College stamp on their own. There will be one sessional examination (instead of two) to be conducted by the concerned teachers. For the time being, the Internal Assessment be based on one sessional examination of 20 marks; in future we may use other modes of assessment such as Home assignment, Seminars, Group Discussion etc as incorporated in the Regulation. The answer scripts of the sessional examination be preserved in the Colleges and be submitted to the University when demanded. The sessional examination be held preferably in the middle of the session (i.e. to be completed by 1<sup>st</sup> half of September) and the marks obtained by the students be announced within one week of the examination. If demanded, the answer scripts be shown to the students.
- (2) There will be a uniform pattern of question papers in the TDC Semester Courses in the End Semester examinations which will be conducted by the University, consisting of the following types of questions covering all the units of the Syllabus.

For the question paper carrying total marks = 80

Objective type	= 1 mark × 10 Qs	= 10 marks
Very short answer type	= 2 marks × 5 Qs	= 10 marks
Short Answer type	= 5 marks × 4 Qs (Out of 6)	= 20 marks
Long Answer or Essay type	= 10 (or 5+5) marks × 4 Qs (Out of 8)	= 40 marks

For question papers carrying total marks = 60.

Objective type	= 1 mark × 7 Qs	= 07 marks
Very short type	= 2 marks × 4 Qs	= 08 marks
Short Answer type	= 5 marks × 3 Qs (Out of 5)	= 15 marks
Long Answer or Essay type	= 10 (or 5+5) marks × 3 Qs (Out of 6)	= 30 marks

The model sample question papers are being prepared and will be given in the University website shortly.

This will come into force with immediate effect.
