ADMISSION INTO LL.M FIRST SEMESTER COURSE FOR THE SESSION 2011

Application in prescribed forms completed in all respects are invited from eligible law graduates of this university or any other recognized University with a minimum of 50% marks, relaxable by 5% marks for SC/ST/OBC/MOBC candidates computed on the basis of marks secured in all part examinations leading to LL.B. degree and will be received in the Department of Law by **08.11.2010**. The University shall not be held responsible for late receipt of application due to postal irregularities or any other reason.

Prescribed application forms with the Prospectus can be obtained from the (i) Gauhati University Publication Department (GUPD) and (ii) G.U. Information Centre, WUS Building, Ambari, Guwahati-1 from **07.10.2010** to **08.11.2010** on all working days between **11:00 a.m.** to **2:00 p.m.** on payment of Rs.250/- (Rupees two hundred fifty) only and an Admission Test fee of Rs.200/- (Rupees two hundred) only has to be deposited in the Department of Law, G.U. at the time of submission of forms.

Admission Test: The eligible candidates to be notified in a list in the Notice Board of the concerned Department after scrutiny will have to appear in a statutory written Admission Test in Jurisprudence, Constitutional Law, Indian Penal Code and Current Legal Problems. The Written Test will be held on **15.11.2010** at **11:00 a.m.** in the Law Department, G.U. Details may be obtained from the Law Department.

The selection of candidates for admission will be made on the basis of their performance in the statutory written Admission Test. List of selected candidates will be notified in the Notice Board of the Department of Law on **07.12.2010** for admission on **15.12.2010**. Classes will commence from 1st week of January, 2011. The timing of classes will be from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and attendance in all classes shall be compulsory under new regulation.

Any misstatement or suppression of material facts or any willful manipulation or presentation of incomplete documents in the application may result in disqualification and legal action.
