**DETAILS REGARDING THE CHAMPIONSHIP ARE AS UNDER: -**

1. Please send your entry through registered mail or email us on dsw@gauhati.ac.in
2. All the teams should report one day earlier at the venue of the competition. Accommodation will be available accordingly.
3. Only unfurnished lodging facility shall be provided by the host University.
4. Participating teams are requested to bring their own locks with key & bedding etc
5. Bedding can be provided only on rental basis if the concerned / participating Universities inform us in advance.
7. All the players are requested to bring their updated Identity Cards of the current session duly signed by the concerned authority.
8. Teams are requested to submit quadruplicate (04) copies of the Eligibility Proforma of the players at the time of registration. Incomplete Proforma will not be entertained. No over-writing is permitted on the Proforma unless attested by the concerned authority.
9. Registration will be done from 11 am onwards at the office of the Director of Students' Welfare with a registration fee of Rs. 1000/- per team.
10. The participating Universities should submit attested photocopies (duly attested by the competent authority) of 10+2 class passed certificate and graduation certificate (if the player is studying in P.G. course) without this the players will not be allowed to participate in these Competitions.
11. Officiating/Umpiring Charges shall be charged as per latest rules of AIU.
12. The participating team will have to deposit a sum of Rs. 2000/- as caution money per team which is refundable.
13. Participating teams shall bring two no.s of their own University Flags. Participation in March Past is compulsory for all the teams.
14. A meeting of all the Managers/coaches of the teams will be held one day prior to the competition at 4pm at the venue which is compulsory.
15. Team managers/ Coaches will be fully responsible for their players to maintain discipline during competition & stay.
16. For any kind of unfair means disciplinary action will be taken as per AIU rules.
17. The organizing committee reserves the right to make any changes in the programme. The decision of the committee shall be final and binding.
18. All matches /events of the above said competition will be conducted according to the rules of concerned federations.

19. Food will not be provided by the organizing committee. However canteens & Food Courts are easily available in the University Campus
