

Two-day National Seminar on STATISTICS FOR PEOPLE, SOCIETY AND ECONOMY



Department of Statistics, Gauhati University February 22-23, 2019

About the seminar:

The Department of Statistics, Gauhati University wishes to organize a Two-day National Seminar on the theme "Statistics for People, Society and Economy" during February 22-23, 2019.

The society is comprised of the people who live in it and the betterment of the society can be ensured only through the overall well-being of these people. For example, so far, it has been observed that only a few statistics regarding the unfortunate happenings taking place in the society are brought forward, but the cause behind those happenings, the socio-economic factors of the culprits in particular are not paid attention to. Statistics has a vital role to play here as with the help of the various statistical techniques, these problems can be analytically addressed and formulated as future research prospects. Hence, the theme of the seminar has been chosen as "Statistics for People, Society and Economy". In view of this, some renowned Statisticians, Economists, Social Activists, etc. will deliver their lectures on the afore-mentioned theme and a panel discussion, which will comprise of panellists from different fields of society such as administration, education, bureaucracy etc. will take place, who will share and disseminate their views on the unsolved problems of the society and also discuss ways to tackle them.

Aims and objectives and target audience/participants of the seminar:

This seminar will try to explore the branches of Statistics which are related to the theme and its allied fields. Researchers will present their findings in form of paper (oral presentation and poster presentation) related to the theme of the seminar and interact with their peer groups in the seminar. An interaction with the Research Scholars, young faculty members and under graduate and post graduate students will also be carried out.

Separate sessions will be organised exclusively for the Under Graduate and Post Graduate Students. In each of these two sessions, the presentations will be organized in two categories: Statistics and Non-statistics. The presenter whose paper will be adjudged the 'best paper' in each category will be rewarded.

Who can apply:

Under graduate students (studying in 4th or 6th semester), Post graduate students and Master's Degree holders who have basic knowledge of statistics; Research scholars and faculty members from colleges/universities/institutes from any discipline who make use of statistics in their research work; Non-academics. Interested persons having basic knowledge of statistics, but who do not wish to present paper may also apply.

Theme of panel discussion:

Role of Statistics in addressing the unsolved and unformulated problems in the society and ways to solve them.

A discussion on the role of Statistics in delving the depths of unsolved and unformulated problems in the society will be held and their solution through rigorous dialogue with the experts will be tried to be arrived at. Also, their scope as a future research prospect will be discussed. Scholars, young faculty members, post graduate and under graduate students will participate in the above mentioned programme. The expected outcome of the panel discussion is to bring to light some research problems related to society spread across the various disciplines which may be taken up by future researchers.
